



STREET'S HOPE PART TIME GROUP FACILITATOR MARCH 2019

BACKGROUND: Street's Hope provides survivor-informed, evidence based services survivors of all forms of human trafficking (labor and sex.) We are client centered and trauma informed, and work with each client to create an individualized program plan to rebuild their lives after their trafficking experience while maximizing self-determination, self-worth, and dignity. We utilize a wraparound services model to provide intensive case management and mental health services, and also provide crisis counseling and psycho-educational group programming in conjunction with community partners at off-site locations.

JOB SUMMARY: Provide 5-10 hours per week of professional and ethical clinical support to people whose lives have been impacted by human trafficking or are seeking harm reduction services. This is accomplished through psychoeducational groups and record maintenance.

EDUCATION/TRAINING/EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:

Master's or Bachelor degree in social work, psychology or related field. The ideal candidate has experience working with adult mental health treatment, addiction, and trauma in a group setting. Experience with facilitating, preparing, and documenting psycho-social educational weekly groups.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

Ability to provide effective group sessions with both families and patients. Ability to maintain strict confidentiality. Ability to teach a wide variety of topics suited for the specific needs of addiction, interpersonal relationships, and life skills and adapt group curricula to meet specific group needs. Requires ability to work some flexible hours.

KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provide professional, respectful and ethical group counseling to adults in a client centered and trauma informed environment. Function effectively with all other members of the clinical team as well as administrative and support staff. Document and prepare group sessions in a timely and accurate manner.
