



## **STREET'S HOPE PART TIME SENIOR CLINICIAN MARCH 2019**

**BACKGROUND:** Street's Hope provides survivor-informed, evidence based services to survivors of all forms of human trafficking (labor and sex.) We are client centered and trauma informed, and work with each client to create an individualized program plan to rebuild their lives after their trafficking experience while maximizing self-determination, self-worth, and dignity. We utilize a wraparound services model to provide intensive case management and mental health services, and also provide crisis counseling and psycho-educational group programming in conjunction with community partners at off-site locations.

**JOB SUMMARY:** Provide 10-15 hours per week of professional and ethical clinical support to people whose lives have been impacted by human trafficking or are seeking harm reduction services. This is accomplished through group and 1:1 counseling, education, and records maintenance.

### **EDUCATION/TRAINING/EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:**

Must be a Licensed Addiction Counselor (LAC) in the State of Colorado. Dual License is preferred, but not required: LAC and a Licensed Clinical Professional Counselor (LCPC), Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) and/or Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT).

### **KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:**

Knowledge of federal, state and local laws pertaining to trauma counseling in an outpatient treatment setting. Skilled in Transdisciplinary Foundations, Clinical Evaluations, Biopsychosocial Assessments, Individualized Treatment Plans, Referrals, Service Coordination, Client, Family and Community Education, Documentation and Professional and Ethical Responsibilities. Skilled in written and oral communication including conflict mediation and creativity in working with a diverse population. Ability to provide effective group and individual sessions with both families and patients. Ability to maintain strict confidentiality. Ability to teach a wide variety of topics suited for the specific needs of addiction. Requires good physical health and ability to work flexible hours.

### **KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Provide professional, respectful and ethical individual and group counseling to adults. Function effectively with all other members of the clinical team as well as administrative and support staff. Provide clinical supervision and support to other clinical staff. Professionally assess patient needs and make appropriate referrals for dual diagnosis, mental health, physician, continued stay reviews and continuing care plans. Document patient progress in a timely and accurate manner. This includes, but is not limited to, completion of biopsychosocial, treatment plans,

progress notes and case presentation. Will need to complete annual continuing education requirements and population specific education.
